Vitiligo - Quality of Life Issues in North Macedonia

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Abstract

Vitiligo causes loss of pigment on the affected areas of the skin and/or mucosae.

It is characterized by milky white, non-scaly macules with distinct margins. Vitiligo has more than a 3000-year history, it was often confused with leprosy and led to greater stigmatization of affected individuals. Vitiligo affects patient's QoL in all of the four different aspects: physical, social. and psychological, occupational. Psychological aspect is the most influent factor that affects the QoL of vitiligo patients. It derives from various subjective symptoms such as depression, anxiety, anger, embarrassment, selfconsciousness. We present for the first time the data on the quality of life in a group of patients in North Macedonia.
